INSTALLATION

Point the Arctic Palm software to the designated .xml file in our automation software.

The file is located in '...\Streaming Services\Format 4.xml'

A) Digilink-Xtreme
C:\Arrakis\Xtreme\Streaming Services
B) New~wave
C:\NEW~WAVE\Streaming Services
C) Digilink-HD
C:\DHD\Streaming Services

Note1: the Category field will be filled with 'Spot', 'Music', or 'Other' depending on the type of audio file.

Note2: if a file exists '...\Streaming Services\Format 4 Music Only.txt' then only 'Music' category files will be logged.

OPERATION NOTES

TESTING ARCTIC PALM

The automation sends Abacast a line of text every time a new audio file is played. To make it easier to test the setup, the automation saves the line that it sends to Abacast in a text file.

The line is located in '\Streaming Services\Format 4.txt'

The data will be formated as in the following example:
