

Library – TM Century music library not titled

Symptoms:

A TM Century Library has been imported into the Xtreme and the Title and Artist information is not recognized.

Solutions:

The Digilink-Xtreme is capable of recognizing Title and Artist information from the TM Century libraries. It will only recognize .mp2 and .mp3 files, NOT .wav format files.

If your libraries are in either .mp2 or .mp3 format, then follow these instructions to label the Title and Artist information:

- 1) import the music libraries into the Digilink-Xtreme library
- 2) it will default to labeling these files as a **90000** cart number and it will say **Title** and **Text**. Find the files that were imported into Xtreme
- 3) in the **Library** screen, double click on one of those audio files to bring up the **Edit Data** screen
- 4) on the bottom of the **Edit Data** screen it should have the option **Gold** highlighted yellow. Click on the **Gold** button. This should label the **Title** and **Artist** information for you. If it does not, then it isn't the proper format
- 5) if it does label it properly, then click Save

If it is labeling it properly then follow these steps:

- 1) go to the **Edit Data** screen for the audio file
- 2) click on the **Gold** button
- 3) click on **Save**
- 4) hit the down key on the keyboard
- 5) repeat steps 2-4 until all the files are done
