

X-Edit – Audio sounds fast or slow

Symptoms:

When using X-Edit the audio sounds improper. The audio sounds too fast and or too slow.

Solutions:

This may be caused by a bad temp file. To correct this issue:

- 1) close the **X-Edit** software
- 2) open the C: drive
- 3) open the Arrakis folder
- 4) open the **Xtreme** folder
- 5) open the **TempFls** folder
- 6) inside here should be a TempRecord.wav, delete this file
- 7) if the problem persists or if you do not find the TempRecord.wav, then repeat these steps on all machines that have the Arrakis software on it

If you are recording a Mix file using X-Edit then follow these steps:

- 1) close the **X-Edit** software
- 2) open the C: drive
- 3) open the Arrakis folder
- 4) open the **Xtreme** folder
- 5) open the **TempFls** folder
- 6) inside here should be a **Mic.wav** or a **Mix.wav**. Delete both of these files. Repeat these steps for all machines that have the Arrakis software on it
